JOB DESCRIPTION

Reporting to the Manager, Applications, the Senior Business Systems Analyst, EAM ('Senior Analyst') plays a crucial role in bridging the gap between business needs and technology solutions that ensures that the City's assets, such as major infrastructure, facilities, equipment, and technology, are effectively utilized and managed to support business operations and outcomes.

As a Subject Matter Expert on Enterprise Asset Management systems with demonstrated knowledge of the complex relationships between the practice of asset management and business operations. This role will work to modernize and support our strategic Asset Management objectives established by a variety of City programs including our Corporate Asset Management program and other client department requirements, through the development of IT systems that integrate people, data and information, tools and processes.

As the Senior Analyst, you will be key in guiding us through the development and support of computer systems, that will support the planning and coordination of lifecycle activities to maintain City owned <u>tangible assets</u>. You will provide excellent client service, working closely with our business partners to understand the current state of an IT system and providing data-driven advice on how to expand or refine its operations to meet the needs of the Business unit, while protecting the integrity of our systems. In addition, you will analyze requirements from multiple business areas to determine the optimal Solution and/or configuration to meet all business needs.

Once the system is operational the Senior Analyst will be responsible for providing analysis, recommendations and support, to ensure optimum functionality and



configuration that supports user requirements. This role will act as a SME on the IT Systems assigned, and will guide the business in using the system to its full capacity.

KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Project Leadership: Lead IT related business improvement initiatives that advance the strategic priorities. Communicate and deliver the overall project delivery strategy using project management methodology. Continuously review project direction and progress to provide subject matter expertise, well developed reporting and communication to key stakeholders and senior management. Ability to foster engagement, debate, lead discussions and build consensus to achieve.
- Demonstrated Competencies: IT systems development and implementation; asset management concepts and practices, and business related analytics, automation and reporting. Actively supports, facilitates, participates and provides input to corporate committees, client departments, staff and industry networks, implementation teams and projects.
- Requirements Gathering: Collaborates with clients to understand their needs, elicit and document detailed requirements for IT systems and applications. Organizes and conducts interviews, workshops, and surveys to gather information.
- Analysis and Documentation: Analyzes gathered requirements and documentation. Creates functional and technical specifications, use cases, process flows, and other relevant documentation to serve as a foundation for development and implementation.
- System Testing: Develops and executes test plans to ensure that IT systems and applications meet specified requirements. Includes functional testing, integration testing, and user acceptance testing.
- Relationship management and Communication: Build and maintain relationships
 with internal/external clients, and core business stakeholders to promote and build
 well-developed service levels that drive business solutions. Acts as a liaison
 between clients and implementation teams. Translate business requirements into
 technical specifications that developers can work with. Leverages strong oral and
 written communication to ensure clear understanding between traditionally
 unrelated clients, groups and implementation teams.
- Problem Solving: Addresses issues and challenges that arise during the development and implementation of IT solutions. Identifies and proposes solutions to overcome obstacles and meet business objectives.
- Compliance and Security: Ensure that the IT systems and applications comply with industry regulations and City standards. Implements measures to protect data and systems.
- Training and Support: Develops content and provides training and support to endusers, ensuring effective utilization. Addresses user questions and issues.
- Continuous Improvement: Continuously updates current knowledge of legislative and industry changes, best practices and competencies, including self. Assesses and informs on potential influence and/or impact to relevant processes, practices and systems. Makes recommendations for improvements to existing systems or the adoption of new technologies to enhance business processes.
